PATTI VILLAGE CLINIC



The Patti Village Clinic in partnership with Child Family Health International (CFHI) is the sole source of healthcare for underserved populations living in the northwestern foothills of the Himalayas. It provides free medical services to local community members and emphasizes the importance of primary health care and preventive medicine. We are proud to present a synopsis of the efforts on work done in 2019 by the Patti Village Clinic funded by CFHI in the following report.

BY THE NUMBERS

2500 community members impacted and sensitized by project

1800 patients served at Patti Village Clinic this year

23 health outreach camps conducted

HIGHLIGHTS

- Major decline in malnutrition among children, especially in adolescents, was achieved
- Under the guidance of local health leaders, CFHI participants taught village children about healthy lifestyles through free yoga classes and basic first aid training



HIGHLIGHTS

- The community increased focus on family planning to maintain better health standards and socio-economic status
- The community better understands the importance of immunization in babies, children, and even adults
- The standard of basic sanitation and hygiene has improved
- Water borne diseases have been checked as the water channels are maintained regularly
- A comparative analysis of Ayurveda and Allopathy was conducted to explain to the village community the holistic approach of the clinic team
