In 2020, CFHI...

- Brought all students safely home without incident at the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Piloted a portfolio of virtual opportunities including internships, practicums, and online courses in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Named Gonzalo Claire, a member of the CFHI Global Team, Virtual Program Coordinator.
- Offered solidarity stipends to all members of our Global Team totaling \$23,175 amidst the halt of place-based programs due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

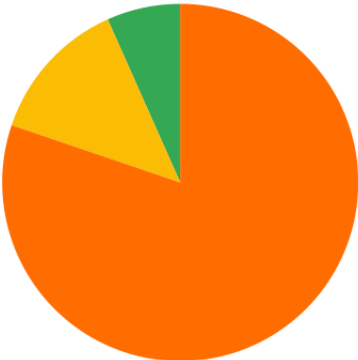
