GAPS + OPPORTUNITIES

CFHI has long-standing relationships with its 23 global sites across nine countries. For every person who participates in CFHI, ~75% of their program fees go directly to the global site hosting them. These fees cover local labor costs, hosting-related expenses, and support for health projects. This is a unique model in the global health field, shifting significant resources to global south-based healthcare professionals.

In addition to program fees, CFHI offers Community Health Project Grants to support underfunded community health work at its global sites. Global Site leaders apply for grants to fund a specific project, ranging from the scaling of mobile clinics in Uganda to community-based mental health support in the Philippines.
